

ST. BARTHOLOMEW'S REFURBISHMENT PROJECT UPDATE



The refurbishment work is progressing very well. The interior painting is now complete, and the stencilling work has commenced. The refurbishment also includes varnishing of floors, upgrade of lighting and re-covering the kneelers as well as other essential improvements. All these elements of the work are in hand and will be completed over the coming weeks. In the meantime, there will be no weekday Masses during this time. Sunday Mass will be held in Knocktemple National School.

To date **€20,235** has been contributed by the people of the Munterconnaught church area. Thank you to all those who have contributed to date, for your generosity. Canon Coslett Quin by Declan Cooney

In 1960, as part of parish rearrangements, the Church of Ireland parish of Munterconnaught was linked with Billis and Ballyjamesduff instead of Lurgan and Loughan, as heretofore. This continued to be the case until 1972. Between 1960 and 1965, the Rector of the parishes of Billis and Ballyjamesduff was the Rev. Canon Coslett Quin. This man was one of Ireland's most noted scholars and linguists of the 20th century. Coslett Quin (Coslett Ó Cuinn) was born in Derriaghy, Co. Antrim, where his father was Rector. He was educated in Campbell College, Belfast, and Trinity College Dublin. He was ordained in 1931 and he first served as curate at Dundela in east Belfast. Already fluent in French and German, he became interested in Irish and devoted time and energy to learning from fluent Irish speakers in Tyrone and Antrim.


During his clerical career, he served in nine different parishes including three in Co. Cavan (the others were Drumlane and Killinagh). In 1961, while he was Rector of Billis and Ballyjamesduff, he was appointed Professor of Biblical Greek in Trinity College and combined this with his parochial duties. He translated the Revised Standard Version of the New Testament from the original Greek into Irish. He retired from parochial ministry in 1971 but he continued his scholarly work for many years, translating the Alternative Prayer Book and Psalms into Irish, as well as numerous prayers and hymns including "Amazing Grace". He also translated theological works from German, Spanish and Hebrew and he is said to have spoken twelve languages.

Canon Coslett Quin died in 1995 and is buried in Dunganstown, Co. Wicklow – the last parish in which he ministered. On his passing, the Irish Times published a fine tribute which concluded "Few men knew Ireland in all its richness and complexity as well as Coslett Quin. He was a true patriot".
